As part of our team, you will play a crucial role in maintaining the library's collection, ensuring our resources remain accessible and organized for all visitors.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Send friendly email reminders to borrowers when their loan periods are nearing completion, encouraging timely returns and helping to maintain the circulation of our collection
- Engage with library visitors, fostering a welcoming and inclusive environment
